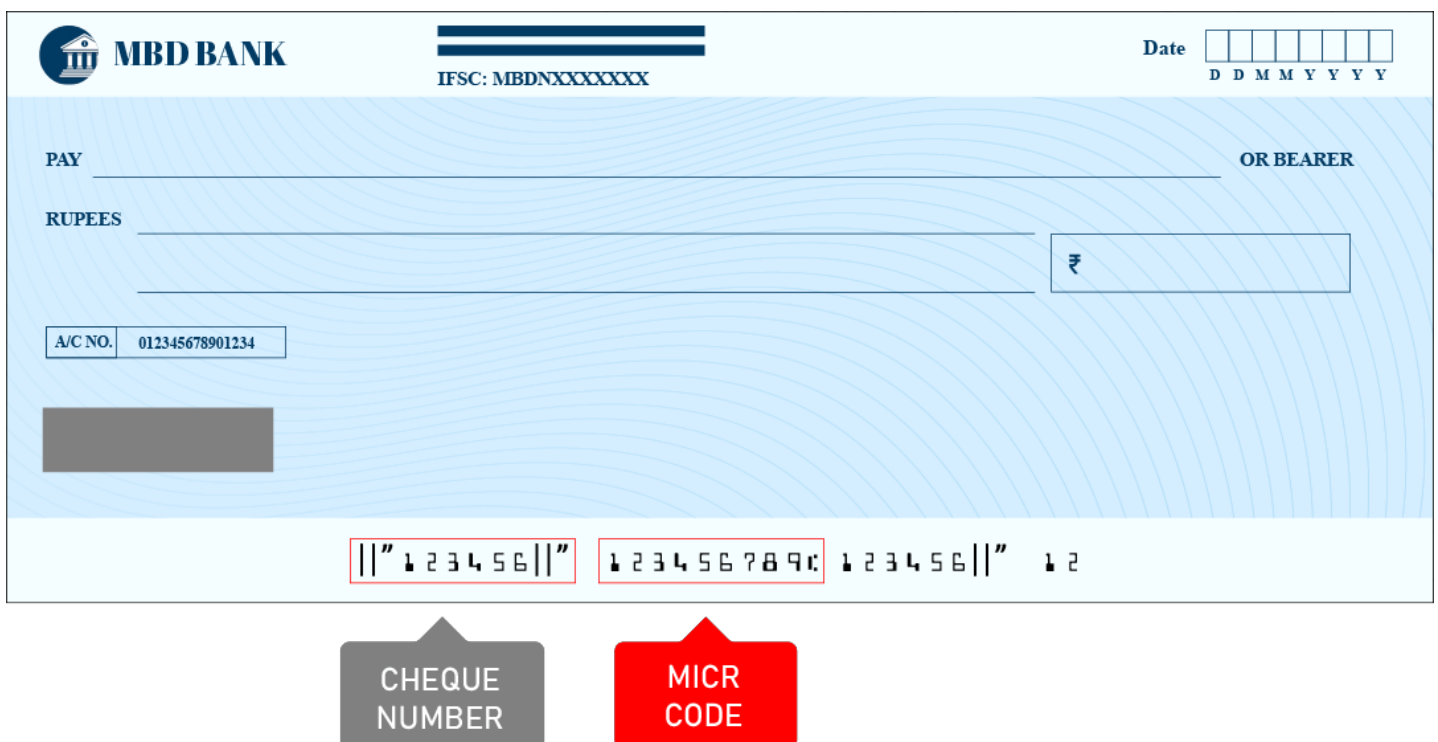

Where is a 411229017 MICR Code on a Check?
