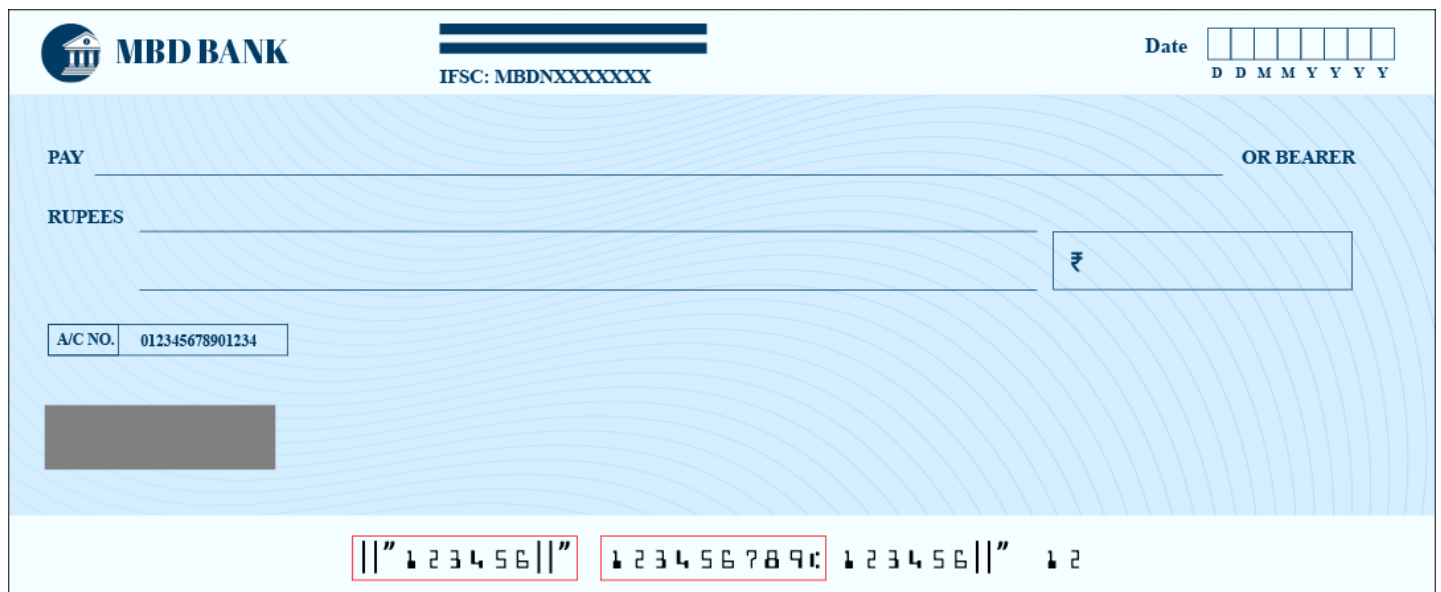

Where is a 431037101 MICR Code on a Check?

You will see the **431037101** MICR Code printed in the bottom left corner of the check. **431037101** MICR Code is a 9-digits code that you will see just before the account number on the check.
