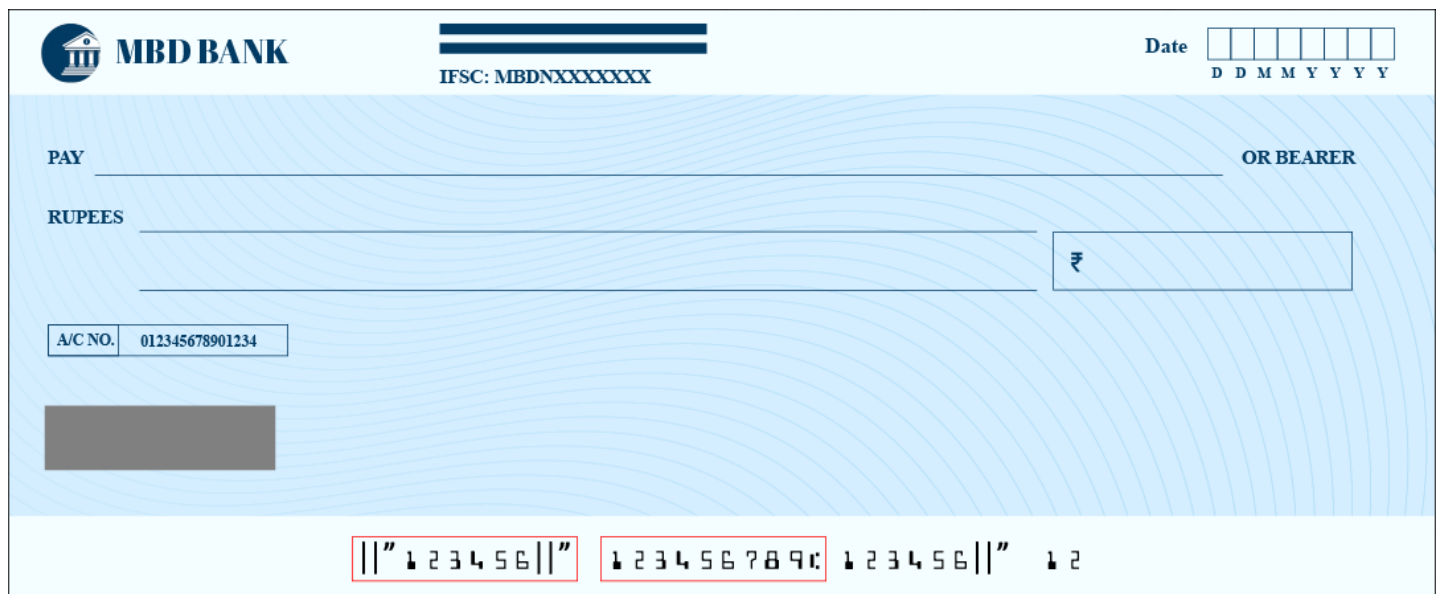

You will see the **520702102** MICR Code printed in the bottom left corner of the check. **520702102** MICR Code is a 9-digits code that you will see just before the account number on the check.
