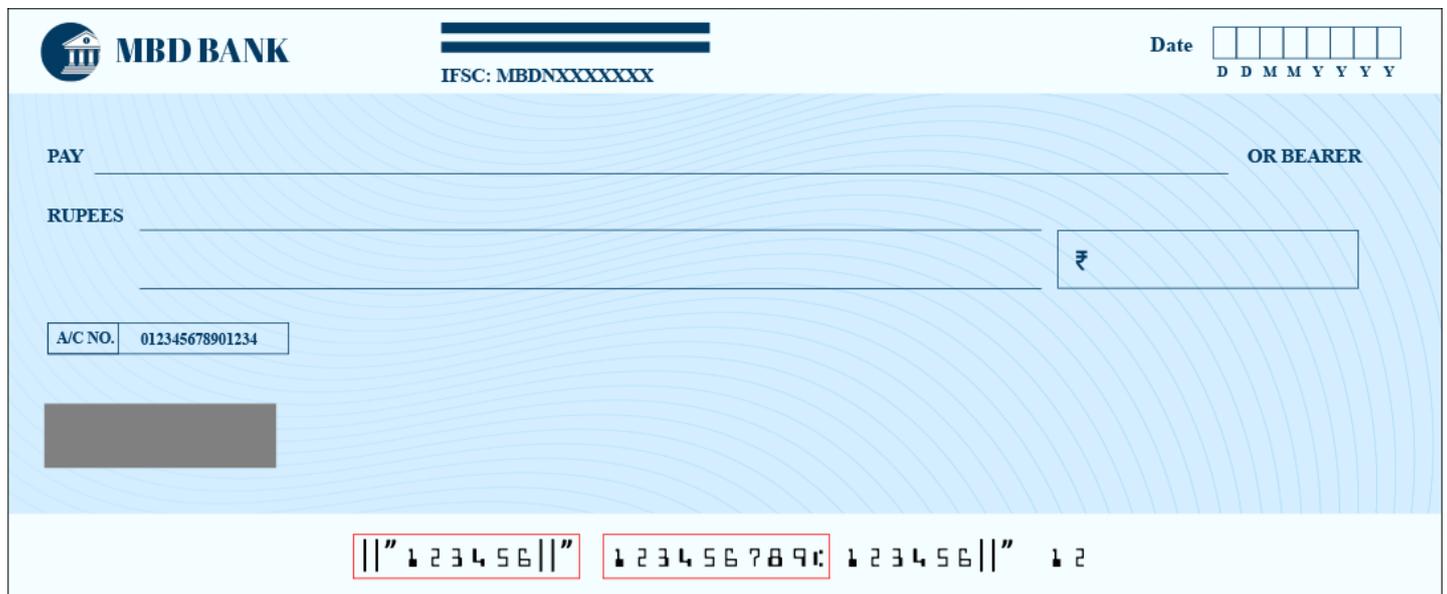

Where is a 755028504 MICR Code on a Check?

You will see the **755028504** MICR Code printed in the bottom left corner of the check. **755028504** MICR Code is a 9-digits code that you will see just before the account number on the check.
