

What is a sort code?

Sort codes are used to identify a particular bank and transaction details in the UK. In the UK, A sort code is a must. You can not transfer money by using only the account number. It's a **six-digit** code that identifies the bank's branch where your account is already held. The given six digits divide into pairs of two numbers like 20-54-58. The **first two** digits identify the bank itself, and the remaining **four** identify the transactions and specific branch details. The sort code is recognized only in the UK.

- 1. 20 First two digits code identifies the branch.
- 2. 54 58 Last four digits code identifies the branch details and transaction details.
